Old Business:

 - Storage shed size 20' x 20'
 - John & Conrad will get quotes for storage shed
2. Electricity for Little League concession stand
 - Brenda hasn't given a total cost yet, Geoff will follow up with Brenda
3. St Joseph's Centennial
 - Geoff will contact Diane Kieffer and call the Diocese office
4. Water Spigots
 - If possible have one on the east & west side of the Church
 - Gwen will contact Ronnie Stellmach
5. Flower Garden
 - On hold until the location of the storage shed is decided
6. Painting & Cleaning
 - Cleaning of the Hall, Geoff will call Service Master to get a bid
 - Deb will call the Diocese office to discuss the insurance coverage if Parish members would do the cleaning
 - Notice was in the bulletin looking for someone to replace the tile in the Hall's entryway, there was no reply to the notice. Ione Sauer volunteer to see if she could find someone
 - Painting the inside of the Church, Gwen will call Gerard Stellmach
 - Carpet for the Church, Geoff will check to see who installed the carpet in Brennyville
7. Sale of Hall tables
 - Deb gave different pricing for tables, estimates about \$1,500.00. Conrad made a motion to buy the new tables, Gwen second the motion, motion was passed to buy new tables.
 - Deb will contact Gilman and Brennyville to see if they would like to purchase the used tables

 - The 7:30 time works the best for Father Leo scheduled Air Force Reserve meetings. There would be a cost to have another Priest have Mass at an earlier time.

 - Evergreen shrubs on the northwest side of the Cemetery doesn't look good
 - Dale will look at trimming it before a decision is made to remove it
