Meeting Minutes

April 21, 2022

Father Mathew called the meeting to order and led the members with an opening prayer.

1. Old Business

- a. Hall Cleaning
- b. Hall Manager

Geoff welcomed Amy Kelash and explained that Amy is interested in the Hall Manager position. The council explained the hall rental fees, cleaning duties and wage. Father said Jan Helmin would take the hall bookings with his approval. Once the event and date was set the Hall Manager would be given the information. The Manager would then take over and would work with the party renting the hall. Amy asked if there would be someone she could reach out to with questions. Geoff will speak to Joyce Helmin & Lou Brown to see if they would be interested in being mentors to the new hall manager. Amy stated she wanted to be considered for the position and the council approved hiring Amy as the Hall Manager. More discussion is needed to finalize everything.

- c. Concerns regarding Quilt Bingo and Fish Fries

Discussed the rising cost of making the quilts and increasing the price charged for the 20 bingo games and 2 black out games. Also discussed having only a one charge for all games. Tabled the discussion until the council meeting next Fall before the Bingo.

Review of the Fish Fries - March 18th sold 464 tickets with a gross income of \$5256.01. April 8th sold 330 tickets with a gross income of \$3990.00. All boxes of fish were accounted for with a few boxes being purchased by council members. Ione will return the remaining boxes to Route 26. Still waiting for invoices before net income is available. Thank you cards were mailed to Dean Zimmerman for donating the potatoes and Brandon Marshik for donating the eggs. There was a great turn out of Volunteers. Decided to have an appreciation potluck. Father's date available was June 5th. Will put an Invitation in the bulletin and also contact all the volunteers, including quilt makers and funeral helpers.

a. Sagging of ceiling panels in the Church

Bob will check with Kevin Stuckmayer to see if he would be able to fix the ceiling panels.

b. Bathrooms in the Church and Hall

Wayne Juetten was called to see if he could fix the toilets in the Church. When Wayne returned the key to the Church to Ione, Wayne told Ione he couldn't get the snake to go through and recommended replacing the toilets. Geoff said he also noticed an issue with the toilet in the mens bathroom in the Hall. Father suggested looking at replacing all of the toilets. Bob will do some research and for now he'll pick up 2 new toilets for the Church.

c. Curtain and Lighting for the south & north wall in the Hall.

Alyssa checked on the cost of replacing the curtains and lighting that was removed from the south and north walls in the Hall. The cost would be around \$425.00 and Roger Brown would be willing to see what would work for hanging the curtains. Will see if this can be done before the 50th Wedding Anniversary booked for May 21st .

Discussed the maintenance on the lawn mower. Bob will check with Jessie Wirth.
